

### **Resolution 63**

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF NORCOM  
APPROVING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FROM QUALIFIED  
VENDORS TO PROVIDE A MOBILE-CAD SOLUTION FOR  
NORCOM'S FIRE AGENCIES.

**WHEREAS**, NORCOM, a consolidated, regional public safety communications center serving police, fire, and emergency medical service providers in northeast King County, seeks to acquire a Fire Mobile-CAD package and support relationship from a vendor interested in long-term partnership with NORCOM; and

**WHEREAS**, NORCOM has prepared a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for such work and now desires to approve and release the RFP to qualified vendors as provided herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the release of the RFP is within the authority of the Executive Director, and the Executive Director has released the same; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board desires to approve issuance of the RFP and ratify all actions taken with respect to the RFP prior to the date of this resolution:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Board of NORCOM as follows:

Section 1. Authorization. The Governing Board hereby approves the Fire Mobile-CAD Solution Request for Proposal (RFP # 2013-03) (the "RFP"), in substantially the form on file with NORCOM staff and incorporated herein by this reference. The Executive Director of NORCOM is hereby authorized to release the RFP to qualified vendors in accordance with its terms. The Selection Committee (as described in the RFP) is hereby authorized to receive and review proposals from vendors as described in the RFP.

The Executive Director is further authorized to enter into negotiations with a vendor selected by the selection committee. The negotiated agreement will be submitted to the Governing Board for consideration and approval.

Section 2. Further Authority; Prior Acts. All NORCOM officials, their agents, and representatives are hereby authorized and directed to undertake all action necessary or desirable from time to time to carry out the terms of, and complete the transactions contemplated by, this resolution. All acts taken pursuant to the authority of this resolution but prior to its effective date are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
