Incumbents must develop a rapid and accurate sense of call interpretation and decision-making/problem solving skills during stressful situations, processing multiple calls simultaneously, establishing the priority status of the call and initiate a sequence of time sensitive actions.

## **Minimum Requirements:**

- Must be 18 years of age at time of hire
- Must type over 40wpm net
- Must have a High School Diploma or equivalent
- Must have permission to work in the US
- Must have excellent written and oral communication skills
