NORCOM – New 911 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS CENTER OPENS

Providing high quality emergency service communications for the citizens of Northeast King County

King County, WA – August 5, 2009

Multiple years of regional cooperation, planning of operational processes, and implementation of integrated public safety technology culminated in the July 1st, 2009 go-live of NORCOM (North East King County Regional Public Safety Communication Agency).

NORCOM became a legal entity in November of 2008 as a result of four years of cooperation by numerous public safety agencies. NORCOM centralizes public safety dispatch services formerly provided by the Bellevue and Kirkland Police communication centers. NORCOM and its participant agencies will utilize a state of the art integrated public safety technology suite that includes computer-aided dispatch, mobile data computers, field reporting, records management and jail management. The professional and efficient answering of 911 phone calls and dispatching of police, fire, and emergency medical services is the basis of why NORCOM was formed.
